Subject: Inviting Applications for Engagement of Project Advisor cum Consultant on Contract Basis

Indradhanush Gas Grid Limited (IGGL), a Joint Venture Company promoted by GAIL (India) Limited, Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited, Oil India Limited and Numaligarh Refinery Limited, is implementing the North East Gas Grid (NEGG) Project to develop natural gas infrastructure across the North-Eastern region of India.

IGGL has recently received authorization from the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) for implementation of the Duliajan Feeder Line (DFL), a 24-inch diameter cross-country natural gas pipeline of approximately 175 km length. The project is of strategic importance and is expected to significantly enhance the capacity and revenue potential of the North East Gas Grid.

To provide strategic guidance, technical expertise, and project management support for execution of ongoing and upcoming pipeline projects, IGGL invites applications from eligible retired senior professionals for engagement as **Project Advisor cum Consultant** on a full-time contractual basis.

Project Advisor cum Consultant shall function as the single-point authority for the execution of the Duliajan Feeder Line project and shall provide leadership and direction to all project teams, contractors, consultants, and support functions involved in the implementation of the project. He shall be responsible for ensuring effective coordination among Engineering, Construction,



Contracts, HSE, Quality Assurance, Finance, Land Acquisition, and other supporting departments to achieve project objectives in a timely and efficient manner.

The incumbent shall be responsible for preparing and implementing detailed execution plans and monitoring physical and financial progress against approved milestones. He shall continuously review project performance, identify bottlenecks, and initiate appropriate mitigation measures to ensure adherence to the project schedule. Regular review meetings with EPC contractors, consultants, and internal stakeholders shall be conducted to ensure seamless execution and timely resolution of issues.

The role shall involve close liaison with Central and State Government authorities, district administration, statutory bodies, landowners, and local stakeholders for obtaining necessary approvals, permissions, right of use, crossing permissions, and other statutory clearances essential for project execution. The incumbent shall maintain effective relationships with various stakeholders and facilitate resolution of issues relating to land acquisition, rehabilitation, and local administration.

The Project Advisor cum Consultant shall supervise all construction activities including stringing, welding, trenching, lowering, backfilling, hydrotesting, horizontal directional drilling crossings, station works, and associated facilities. He shall ensure the availability of resources, including manpower, materials, and equipment, and shall monitor contractor performance to ensure adherence to approved specifications, standards, and construction methodologies.

The incumbent shall be responsible for ensuring strict compliance with applicable HSE requirements, PNGRB regulations, OISD standards, and industry best practices. He shall promote a culture of safety and operational excellence and strive to achieve zero major incidents throughout the execution period. Quality assurance and quality control measures shall be continuously monitored to ensure conformity with approved standards and specifications.

The incumbent shall be responsible for effective contract administration, including review and verification of bills, examination of variation proposals, evaluation of contractual claims, and resolution of technical and contractual issues in coordination with the concerned departments. Continuous monitoring of project expenditure and budgetary provisions shall be undertaken to ensure optimum utilization of resources and cost control.

The role also encompasses identification and management of project risks and implementation of suitable mitigation measures relating to statutory approvals, contractor performance, logistics, security, stakeholder management, and other project-related challenges. Critical issues affecting project progress shall be promptly escalated to the Management along with suitable recommendations for decision-making.

The incumbent shall be responsible for coordinating pre-commissioning and commissioning activities, ensuring completion of punch points, facilitating statutory inspections and approvals, and ensuring readiness for gas-in operations. He shall also ensure proper documentation and seamless handover of facilities to the Operations Department for commercial operation.

The incumbent is expected to demonstrate a high degree of ownership, accountability, and leadership while maintaining the highest standards of integrity, transparency, and professionalism. He shall foster teamwork, promote effective communication, and represent the Company before

Government authorities, consultants, contractors, promoters, and other external stakeholders. He shall provide regular updates to the Management and ensure timely submission of progress reports and management information systems.

The incumbent is expected to ensure safe, timely, and cost-effective completion and commissioning of the Duliajan Feeder Line project while maintaining operational excellence, stakeholder confidence, and adherence to all statutory and contractual requirements. The position carries complete responsibility and accountability for successful execution and delivery of the project in line with the objectives and strategic priorities of Indradhanush Gas Grid Limited.

2. Eligibility Criteria

A. Service Background

The applicant should have superannuated from a Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) in any of the following pay scales :

- Rs. 7,250–8,250 (IDA) Pre-01.01.1992
- Rs. 9,500–11,500 (IDA) Post-01.01.1992
- Rs. 20,500–26,500 (IDA) Post-01.01.1997
- Rs. 51,300–73,000 (IDA) Post-01.01.2007
- Rs. 1,20,000–2,80,000 (IDA) Post-01.01.2017
- Rs. 18,400–22,400 (CDA) Pre-revised Post-01.01.1996
- Rs. 37,400–67,000 + Grade Pay ₹10,000 (CDA) Post-01.01.2006
- Level-14 (₹1,44,200–2,18,200) under 7th CPC.

Retired executives from State Public Sector Enterprises, Private Sector Companies, Joint Ventures and National/State Cooperative Federations may also apply, provided they held Board-level positions or one level below Board level and belonged to organizations having an average annual turnover of ₹10,000 crore or above during the preceding three financial years. Preference shall be given to candidates from listed companies.

3. Experience Requirements

The applicant should possess:

- Minimum 15 years of experience in execution and management of cross-country natural gas pipeline projects of 24-inch diameter or above.
- At least four years' experience during the last eight years preceding retirement as Project In-Charge or in an equivalent leadership position.
- Extensive hands-on experience in pipeline engineering, construction, commissioning, operation and maintenance of natural gas pipeline systems.

- Expertise in contractor management, project coordination, statutory clearances and resolution of execution-related issues.
- Thorough knowledge of the Petroleum and Minerals Pipelines (Acquisition of Right of User in Land) Act, 1962 and other applicable statutory and regulatory provisions.
- Preference shall be given to candidates who have experience in projects located in the North-Eastern Region or other geographically challenging terrains.
- Working knowledge of local languages of the project areas will be desirable.

4. Remuneration

The consolidated monthly remuneration, together with pension being drawn by the individual, shall not exceed the Last Pay Drawn immediately prior to retirement. The remuneration of Executives retired from private organization shall be fixed pay scale of Rs.1,20,000–2,80,000 (Basic Pay only) through negotiation, if found suitable.

The remuneration once fixed, shall remain unchanged during the period of engagement.

The Project Advisor cum Consultant shall continue to draw pension and dearness relief on pension as admissible under applicable rules. The engagement shall not be construed as re-employment.

Applicable Income Tax/TDS shall be deducted at source.

5. Leave and Travel

The Project Advisor cum Consultant shall be eligible for paid leave of absence up to 1.5 days per completed month of engagement on a pro-rata basis. Unavailed leave shall neither be carried forward nor encashed.

No TA/DA shall be admissible for joining or completion of the assignment.

Foreign travel shall not be permitted. However, for official domestic travel undertaken with prior approval, Daily Allowance up to ₹1,000 per day shall be admissible as per IGGL rules.

6. Other Terms and Conditions

- The engagement shall be purely contractual and temporary in nature. It should not be construed as a regular appointment in any circumstance.
- The engagement shall initially be for one year and may be extended by another year based on performance and organizational requirements.
- Either party may terminate the engagement by giving one month's notice without assigning any reason.



- The Project Advisor cum Consultant shall work on a full-time basis and shall not undertake any other employment, assignment or consultancy during the period of engagement.
- The Project Advisor cum Consultant may be required to undertake extensive field visits and site inspections.
- Only basic office facilities shall be provided by IGGL.
- No entitlement shall accrue towards DA, residential accommodation, transport facility, medical reimbursement, CGHS, personal staff, telephone, internet facility, or any other service-related benefits.
- The Project Advisor cum Consultant shall adhere to prescribed office hours and may be required to work beyond normal office hours or on holidays depending upon project exigencies, without any additional remuneration.
- The Project Advisor cum Consultant shall maintain absolute integrity and confidentiality and shall execute a Non-Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement.
- All records, reports, documents, data and materials generated during the assignment shall remain the exclusive property of IGGL.
- The engagement shall be governed by Department of Expenditure OM No. F. No. 3-25/2020-E.IIIA dated 09.12.2020, CVC Circular No. 07/05/2021 dated 03.06.2021 and instructions issued from time to time.

7. Vigilance Clearance

The applicant should possess an unblemished service record. Engagement shall be subject to vigilance clearance in accordance with CVC Circular No. 07/05/2021 dated 03.06.2021. Engagement of Executives retired from private organization shall be subject to successful Character and Antecedent Verification.

8. Selection Process

Applications received shall be scrutinized by a Selection Committee comprising representatives from HR, Finance and Project Departments. Shortlisted candidates may be called for interaction/interview, if considered necessary.

The recommendations of the Committee shall be placed before the Competent Authority. The decision of IGGL shall be final and binding.
